WHY DRAW THE LINE

Actions like this can be a warning for violence. These tricks are used to lure and force young women and girls into sexual exploitation.

WHEN TO DRAW THE LINE

Unhealthy ideas about relationships can lead to accepting disrespectful treatment as 'affection'; threatening one's safety.

HOW TO DRAW THE LINE

Sexual exploitation of women and girls is real. Bystanders can play an important role.

Trust Your Gut. When you see it in someone's relationship, check in with them. Ask her: "How can I help you?"

Learn more, get involved. Help challenge attitudes and actions that lead to the sexual exploitation of women and girls.
