HOW TO DRAW THE LINE

Tell your teammate that their behaviour is not welcomed.

Talk about it: Invite your teammates and fans to a community dialogue about sexual violence.

Be Part of the Solution: Dedicate a game to raising awareness about violence against women.

Our actions affect others: You and other male athletes can play a positive role in ending sexual violence.
